15 Having read and considered the pleadings, declarations, and other evidence submitted in this matter, the
16 Court makes the following findings and orders:

17 **A. Procedural History**

18 1. On for hearing is Petitioner's 1/18/2024 Request for Order to compel responses (Set Two),
19 production of documents (Set Two), and \$1,400 in sanctions. Petitioner failed to file a proof of service
20 upon Respondent.

21 2. On 1/22/2024 and 2/22/2024, Respondent filed Responses to the above request. Respondent

3 4. **Preparation of Order:** If you are directed by the court to prepare the order after hearing – within

5 for approval, and follow the procedures set forth in CA Rules of Court, Rule 5.125(c), or (b) If the other

15 Having read and considered the pleadings, declarations, and other evidence submitted in this matter, the
16 Court makes the following findings and orders:

17 **A. Procedural History**

18 1. On for hearing is Petitioner's Request for Order to not be responsible for spousal support to
19 Petitioner and for Respondent's Response to be stricken.

20 2. Respondent was personally served on 2/8/2024 and he did not file a Responsive Declaration.

21 **B. Findings and Orders**
